#### **MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD ZANOTTI:**

Project Advance - Our goal to be paid to the archdiocese this year, 2024, is \$55,100 and so far we have only collected \$17,246. We have 1,360 families registered in the parish. In 2023 in the Project Advance Campaign only 238 donors participated and so far in campaign 2024 only 74 have donated. On top of the \$55,100 goal we also have to pay our portion of the expenses of the campaign. We would like to increase the number of parishioners participating. I am grateful to all those that have already donated but am asking that all parishioners participate even with a minimal donation. We are hoping to receive a rebate in order to pay for some maintenance projects regarding air conditioning and washrooms as well as begin a fund for some building and remodeling at St. James and St. Ann school.


