The enhancement committee has worked diligently to capture all the conclusions raised at the spiritual conversations/ synodal discussions and to synthesize them into a pastoral plan for the parish under three main themes, "communion", "participation" and "mission".

The plan ended up to be four pages long and so the committee created a one page brief which captures the main points of the longer version.

A copy of the brief will be inserted in the bulletin and the longer version will appear on our web page. It is a plan for the next five years but is a dynamic plan that can be adapted regularly after evaluation. I am looking forward to share this plan with you at all the masses next weekend.






