In the gospel, James and John ask to rule with Christ in glory. Jesus rejects their request; his followers must drink from his cup of suffering and be renewed by sharing in the cross. 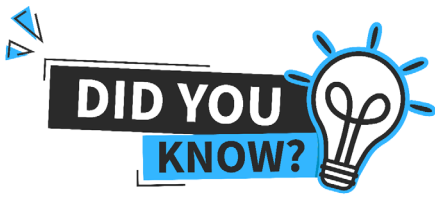
