MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD ZANOTTI: XVI ORDINARY GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF THE SYNOD OF BISHOPS (Second Session 2-27 October 2024) Final document (excerpts).

For a synodal Church: **Communion, Participation, Mission**

Introduction: Jesus came, stood among them and said to them: "Peace be with you!". Having said this, he showed them the hands and the side. And the disciples rejoiced when they saw the Lord (John 20:19-20).

Every new step in the life of the Church is a return to the source, an experience renewed of the encounter with the Risen One that the disciples experienced in the Cenacle on the evening of Easter. We too, participating in this Synodal Assembly, felt like them enveloped by His mercy and touched by His beauty. Living the conversation in the Spirit, listening to each other, we perceived His presence among us: the presence of Him who, by giving the Holy Spirit, continues to inspire unity in His People which is harmony of differences.

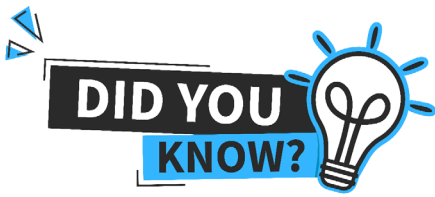
