#### **MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD ZANOTTI:**

XVI Ordinary Assembly of the Synod of Bishops - Final Document

Contemplating the Risen One, we remember that "we were baptized into his death" (Rom 6,3). We have seen the signs of His wounds, transfigured by a new life, but engraved for always in His humanity. These wounds continue to bleed in the bodies of many brothers and sisters, also because of our faults. The gaze on the Lord does not distance us from the dramas of history, but opens our eyes to recognize the suffering that surrounds us and penetrates us: the faces of children terrified by war, the crying of mothers, the broken dreams of many young people, the refugees who face terrible journeys, the victims of climate change and social injustices.

Their sufferings have resonated among us not only through the media, but also in the voice of many, personally involved with their families and their people in these tragic events. In the days in which we were gathered in the Assembly, many, too many wars have continued to cause death and destruction, desire for revenge and loss of consciences. We join Pope Francis' repeated calls for peace, condemning logic of violence, hatred, revenge and committing ourselves to promoting that of dialogue, of brotherhood and reconciliation. Authentic and lasting peace is possible and together we can build it." The joys and hopes, the sadness and anxieties of today's men, of the poor above all and of all those who suffer" (GS 1) were once again the joys and sadness of all of us, disciples of Christ.


