MESSAGE FROM FR. RICHARD ZANOTTI:

"Advent is never more joyous than on this Sunday. Even God will sing and dance in our midst! How the Lord longs to be with us for ever; his love will make us new, we respond to God's unfathomable love with our own songs of worship.

We can know the happiness which Paul wanted for the Christians of Philippi if we really believe in Christ's nearness. Instead of giving in to worry, let us pray with thanks, confident of God's love; then we will be filled with peace. But this happiness is not gained without effort. The gospel calls for concrete proof of conversion in our daily life. It is Christ we await, and we must not allow anyone to usurp his place. Even the Baptist, greatest of prophets, only prepared the way. Christ's nearness demands a decision on our part, for we will be baptized wither with the Holy Spirit or with the fire of judgement. John urges us to accept the Spirits' cleansing and the Good news of Jesus. The fruit if that choice is joy and peace, the enjoyment of God's presence. Can we choose otherwise?"


Book of the Month


