Book of the Month


"How God Loves You -The Love of The Trinity" by Jonathan Vogel It is a small book where God in the three persons addresses us directly. It captures our faith in



Did you know? - Season of Advent — As Christmas draws nearer, each candle brings a little more light into the darkness. The white candle is lit on Christmas Eve or Christmas Day to symbolize that Jesus is with us. The three purple candles are lit on the first, second, and fourth Sundays of Advent. They represent a time of prayer, penance, sacrifice, and spiritual reflection. The pink candle was lit on the third Sunday of Advent. "Rejoice in the Lord always. I will say rejoice!" (Philippians 4:4).
