When you actually fall radically in love with someone, the terms of that relationship are simply a fruitful way to maintain and deepen the love you have for one another. Without falling in love with God, how can you expect to understand His Ways. You can't. God is love.



# Book of the


"How God Loves You -The Love of The Trinity" by Jonathan Vogel




