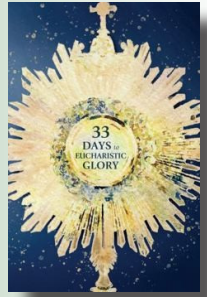

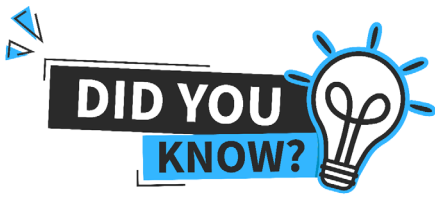

1. Advent, preparation for the birth of Jesus.
2. Christmas is the celebration of God's son birth, Jesus, Emmanuel, God is with us.
3. Ordinary Time is the season between Advent and Christmas and Lent and Easter.
4. Lent is a 40 day season of prayer, fasting, and almsgiving that begins on Ash Wednesday and ends at sundown on Holy Thursday. It's a period of preparation to celebrate the Lord's Resurrection at Easter.
5. Easter or Paschal celebration is Jesus resurrection from the dead.
