MESSAGE FROM FATHER RICHARD ZANOTTI:

The scriptures of this Lenten Liturgical Season call us to conversion, to a change of heart and mind, a turning from sin and turning to God. Our prayers, fasting and our giving something up for Lent should also lead us to conversion but if not then these pious practices become some sort of external exercise with which we can console ourselves that we have somehow fulfilled our duty. As we begin Lent let us not forget what was said when we received ashes, "Turn from sin and believe in the gospel." This is a clear call to conversion. Perhaps to start this journey of conversion we need to seek forgiveness through the sacrament of Reconciliation. In the sacrament we commit to a firm purpose of amendment, we commit to continue our journey of conversion. Let us pray that we may make this Lenten season a true journey of conversion, that we may turn from sin and turn to God.




BOOK OF THE MONTH
